TOURNAMENT RULES

- 30,000 tournament chips.
- 20-minute levels 1-12. 30-minute levels 13+.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand. The ante is paid after the big blind. The ante will not reduce.
- On-Site Registration and Re-Entries are available until the start of Level 13 of this event. Approximately 3:30PM for 11AM flights and 8:30PM for 4PM flights.
- An eliminated player may Re-Enter the event. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- Day One will play to 12.5% rounded up. All players that make Day Two will be in the money.
- This is a best bag forward event. If a player qualifies more than once, the largest bag will be taken forward to Day Two and the smallest bag will receive a minimum cash.
- Day Two will begin at the lowest Day One finishing time.
- Seating may be limited for this event.
- TDA rules apply. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event.
- Redraw at the end of Day 1, 27, and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- Winners will be paid in casino chips.
- All tax laws foreign and domestic apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- \$200 will go to the prize pool. \$50 will go toward administrative fee. Administrative fee includes all staffing/dealer fees, and rake.
